Lamoille County Field Days is looking forward to a great year this year. Due to circumstances beyond our control, last year wasn't exactly a banner year for any of us. We appreciate those of you who are going to give it another go this year. Without our vendors, our fair would not be what it is. **You make it successful for us year after year.**

Please remember that all outside vendors will be given 15' depth only. This includes your storage vehicles. If you need more space, you are charged an addition \$15 per foot. As always, if you are not set up by 8:00 on Friday, July 28th, you will not be allowed to set up and your deposit will be forfeited.

Due to major safety concerns, all vehicles must be in designated parking spaces by 8:00 each day. **No vehicles will be allowed on the grounds after this time.**

The Board of Directors must approve all concessions before permission to participate is granted. We have a "do not compete" rule so that everyone is successful. If this is your first year, or you have made changes in your menu, we will need a description of what items you sell. A picture of your booth would be helpful also. If the Board does not accept your application, your deposit will be returned in full. Be specific with what products you see, and accurate with the dimensions of your booth. Please don't write down "same as last year". You will receive a confirmation once your application and deposit are received and approved. A \$100 fee will be charged the following year if contracted times of set up and tear down are not adhered to.

Please understand that submitting an application does not secure your spot, once applications have been submitted they will be reviewed by the board and confirmation or explanation will be sent.

Due to the high demand in camping requests, in order to reserve a spot on our grounds, a camping deposit of \$50 must be received with your application. The cost is \$25 per night. An additional \$30 will be charged if you use our dumping station.
