5. There will be separate adult (17 & up) and youth (16 & under) divisions. They will be displayed and judged separately.
6. Registration- Please bring your exhibits to the Arts & Crafts building during the hours listed below. Failure to do so will prohibit your items from being judged. If it is impossible for you to bring your items during this time, please find someone who will bring them for you.
